Archive Development Policy

The purpose of gathering and archiving the Club's historical material is to document the use of the Balmoral Beach Club premises, Edwards Beach and Hunter's Bay, from the time of the Club's inception in 1914 to the present.

The Club plans to acquire and preserve material for the use of Balmoral Beach Club members, the local community, historical societies and related sporting organisations. The archives will be available to historians and others interested in researching the use of this portion of Sydney's waterways.

The archives contain photographs, film, press clippings, Club reports and newsletters covering a period of over 90 years. Most of the material has been donated by Club members from their private collections, or generated by Club members on behalf of the Club.

Archive Preservation Policy

The primary aim of preserving records and memorabilia is to increase community access to material and information contained in the Balmoral Beach Club's archives, including items of key historical interest and material not readily accessible due to its fragility. The Club will seek expert advice about the best way to display its archival collection, and it will collaborate with a professional conservator to find the best way to preserve this valuable material.
